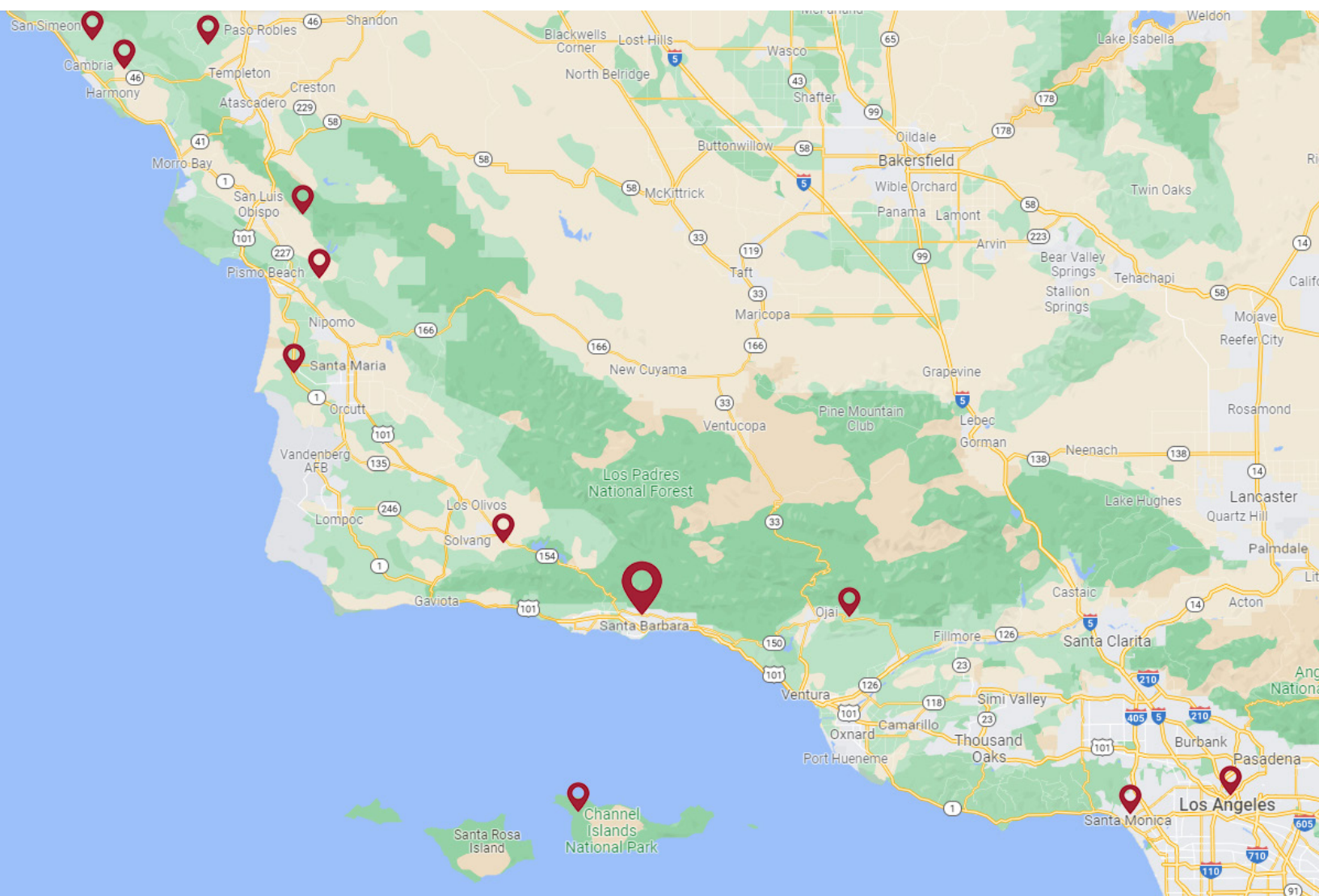

DAY TRIPS FROM SANTA BARBARA

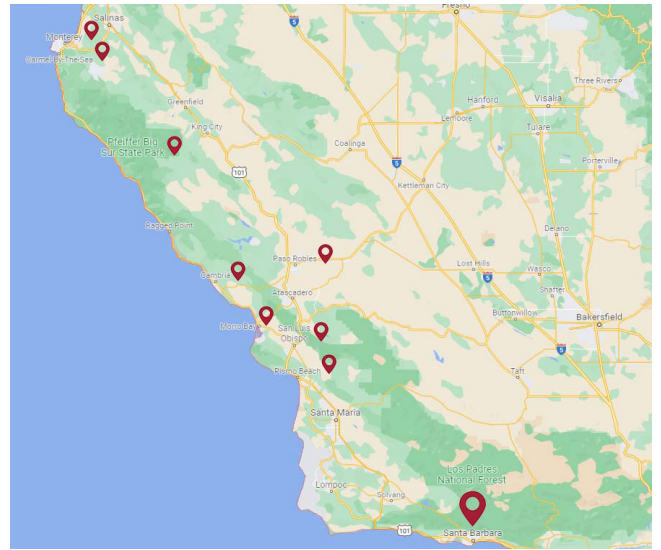

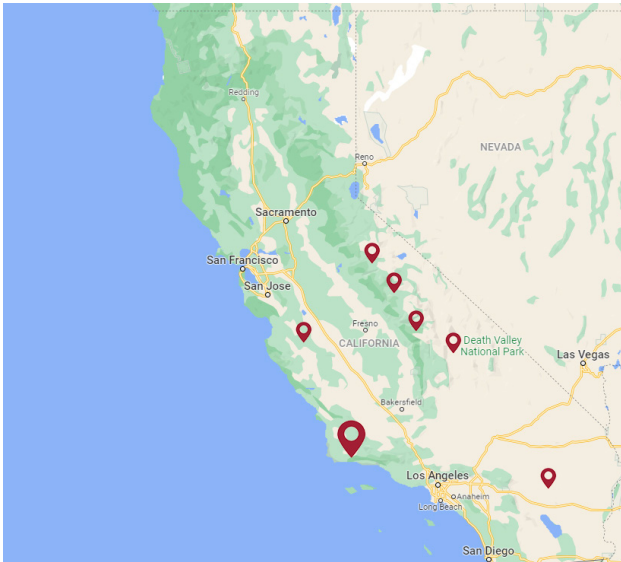
CENTRAL COAST EXPLORATION
